Painting Collages Materials List

If you'd like to bring your own materials, bring:

1. **Xerox copies of your own photographs (not inkjet copies)** - old family photographs?
snapshots of family and friends? your own landscape or travel photos?
OR magazine photographs that appeal to you
2. **Golden Soft Gel medium** - Gloss or Matte
(Gloss will make your colors deeper and richer - and glossy,
and Matte is good for giving an old-timey feel or reducing gloss if you don't like it)
3. **Paint brushes for acrylic painting**
4. **Water container** (preferably plastic - i.e. yogurt container)
5. **Paper towels**
6. **Disposable paper palette** (comes in a pad)
OR paper plates to use as a palette (the kind with a waxy surface)
7. **Acrylic paints**, in whatever colors you'd like to work with
either artist's acrylics in tubes, or craft acrylic paints in bottles
8. **Brush cleaner** ("The Masters" Brush Cleaner is best - a small tub is fine)
9. **Surfaces to paint on - your choice:**
gessoed masonite or hardboard panels, canvas boards, or canvas
(a hard surface is better for working on), in smaller sizes (between 5"x5"
and 9"x 12" – depending on the size, bring two or three
OR watercolor paper, bristol board, acrylic painting paper,
or canvas paper in smaller sizes (5"x7" to 9"x12")
WITH artist's tape or painter's tape to tape it to a painting board
