## Welcome to Plein-Air Painting for Adults:

The following list should get you started.

Please note: The following list is designed for Acrylic painting, but you will find the same colors in oil, should you wish to go that route. Theoretically, one can make any color with the three primary colors of red, yellow and blue... but unfortunately not all brands of Acrylic have pure color pigment.... With that in mind, please purchase quality acrylic such as Blick, Liquitex or Golden's brand paint.

- \*Titanium White--Large tube
- \*Yellow Cadmium Light
- \*Red Cadmium Light
- \*Ultramarine Blue
- \*Cerulean Blue
- \*Alizeran Crimson (Quinacridone Crmson)
- \* Yellow Ochre
- \* Sap (medium) Green
- \* Dioxidine Purple

You can purchase inexpensive acrylic brushes: filberts #2, #6, #8 and one or two round brushes... or you can find sets for a very reasonable price. You can also buy a very inexpensive 2" house-painting brush for painting the color ground on your canvas... (optional)

A variety of canvas boards ... start small 9x12, 11x14, 12x16... or you can purchase a stretched canvas of the same size. There are also canvas pads of unstretched canvas, but this will require that you tape the canvas to a board.

\*\* Liquitex or Golden's retarder in a plastic bottle (not tube) and "ideally" a closed plastic palette box. For acrylic, please come with a water spray bottle to keep your palette wet, water for brushes, plastic or tin containers and paper towels for clean up. \* Please bring a plastic bag for debris regardless of what medium you use.
