

# Materials List

## You will need:

### **Acrylic painting brushes**

preferably long-handled  
in a range of sizes... at least two or three brushes  
(if you are about to buy new brushes, buy filberts)

**Water container** (preferably plastic – large yogurt or cottage cheese containers work well)

### **Paper towels**

**Palette** (a disposable paper palette OR white paper plates – the kind with a waxy finish)

### **Acrylic paints:**

Titanium white  
Whatever colors you have (and want to paint with). We'll winnow them down. If you don't have other colors yet, choose one tube each of yellow, red, and blue – choose colors that you absolutely love. More questions? Color is complicated! Call Karen at (707) 942-0197.

**Canvas, canvas board, illustration board** or **gessoed masonite**  
preferably 11" x 14", 14" x 18", or 16" x 20"

**"The Masters" brush cleaner** (a small tub will last you a very long time)

### **A good selection of your own photographs to paint from**

In choosing potential photographs to paint from, look for subjects that are not overly complicated. (Remember to Keep It Simple, Sweetie!)

**The painting surfaces of your choice:** acrylic painting paper, canvas paper, canvas boards, gessoed masonite, or canvases as your painting surfaces

**Clothing you can paint in:** don't count on getting any acrylic paint out of your clothes once it's there (although rubbing alcohol will help)
